Conditions and Rules

The Evening News and Edinburgh Leisure offer the Dispatch Braid Hills Golf Trophy under the following Conditions and Rules.

Conditions

- 1 The Trophy shall be for Annual Competition, and shall not be won outright by any club. Should any club win the tournament three times in succession the directors of the Evening News will make a suitable presentation.
- 2 The expenses of running the competition shall not be borne by them but no expenses shall be incurred except with the consent of Edinburgh Leisure
- 3 The competition shall be under the management of Edinburgh Leisure

Rules

- 1 The Competition shall be open to Amateur Members of properly constituted Golf Clubs. Each Club to be represented by four players who must have been member of the club for which they have entered for six months prior to 1st of May 2019. No player will be eligible to play for more than one team.
N.B.- New clubs must have a membership or foundation membership of not less than 20 and must have been in existence for a period of not less than one year prior to 1st February 2019.
- 2 Play in the tournament shall be limited to a maximum of 128 Clubs. If in any the total entry exceeds 128 all of which are eligible under the rules preference shall be given to clubs who played in the previous year any remaining places being filled by ballot from the remaining entries. Such ballot shall be made by Edinburgh Leisure.
- 3 The following shall not be eligible to enter for the tournament:
 - a) Professional Golfers.
 - b) Those who exploit their skill at the game or allow their skill to be exploited for profit.
- 4 **All teams beginning the Competition shall play to the end without change and in the same order.** However up to two substitutions will be permitted. **Substituted players may reinstate in their original order of play.** Edinburgh Leisure must be notified of all changes before play.
- 5 The competition shall be played on the tournament principle by foursomes drawn against each other by ballot Club against Club.
- 6 One round of the Braids course shall constitute each game.
- 7 In the event of a tie the clubs shall proceed without interval to the first teeing ground as directed by Edinburgh Leisure and play on until one secures the advantage – the advantage to be reckoned on the double foursome hole by hole.
- 8 The counting shall be by club totals.
- 9 Play shall be by holes according to the rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club St Andrews.
- 10 The draw shall be conducted as follows: Depending on the number of entries such number of byes shall be drawn as shall after the completion of the first round leave 8 16 32 or 64 Teams and one draw shall decide the order of play throughout the competition.
- 11 All disputes shall be settled by Edinburgh Leisure whose decision shall be final.
- 12 The winning club will retain the trophy for a year but will not be able to remove the Trophy from the Braid Hills unless insurance is provided. The winning club, may by consent of the Evening News be able to have the Trophy at a later date for a period of time. It must then be returned to Evening News.
- 13 Edinburgh Leisure shall have power to disqualify a team from taking part in the tournament on being satisfied that any member of the team is holding up play.
- 14 The winning club must report the score to the tournament headquarters which will be based in the Scotsman Lounge.
- 15 Clubs with a total membership of more than 50 may enter a second or third team .These must be clearly identified on the entry form to avoid confusion. No player may play for more than one team. Team 1 will take priority should the entry exceed 128 Teams
- 16 Clubs regardless of membership numbers and who operate a senior section may enter a seniors team. All players must be members of the clubs senior section. No player may play for more than one team.
- 17 Clubs operating a junior section may enter a junior team. Players must be 12 years of age or over.
