- The refurbishment was led by the Fitness Manager, supported by the Gym Development Manager and Venue Manager.
- Proposals were discussed internally and approved by the Senior Leadership Team (SLT).
- External input was provided by Track My Gym (TMG) through equipment usage data and customer surveys.
- Considerations focused on space constraints and demand for free weights. TMG surveys informed decisions to remove a Skill Mill, one treadmill, and one cross trainer to create additional space.
- A report created in April 2025 on class usage at Warrender Swim Centre showed an average of 4–5 participants per class.

Information Not Held:

- No formal meeting minutes were recorded.
- Customer research did not identify significant requirements for changes to coached classes.

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Key Findings:

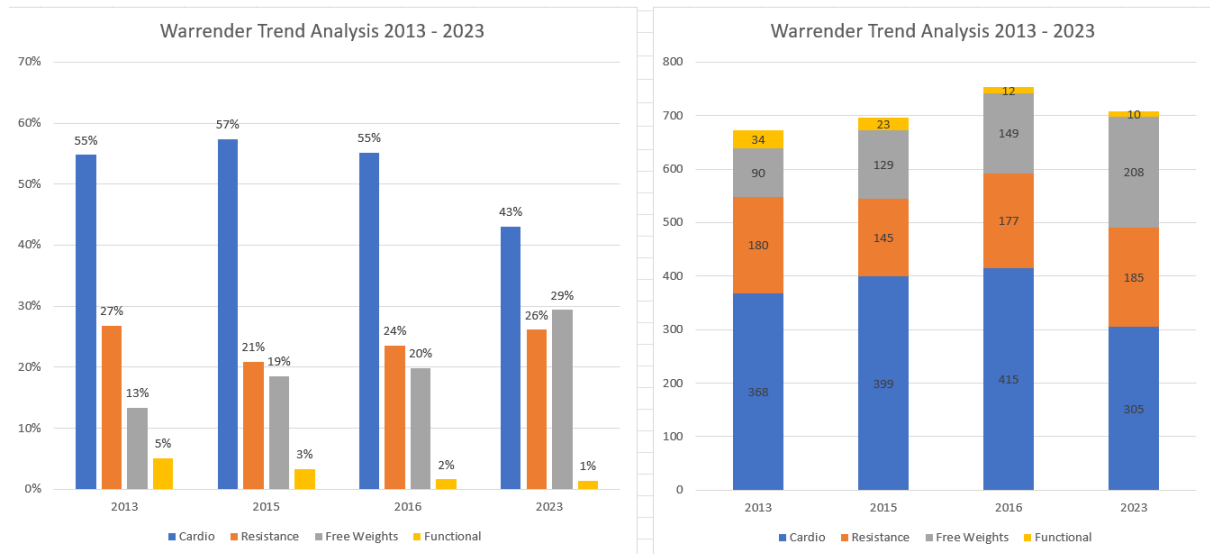
- Free weights usage increased by 131% from 2013 to 2023.
- Resistance training grew slightly (+3%), while cardio and functional training declined.
- Trend analysis indicates that adapting to member demand is essential to maintain engagement and avoid membership loss.
